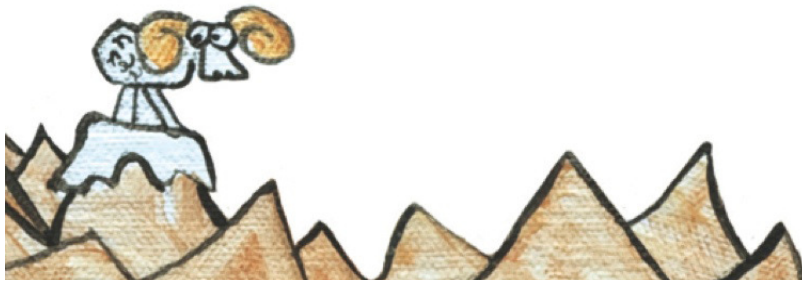

Beethoven

Length of presentation – 60 min

In this presentation the Life and Times of Ludwig Van Beethoven will be explored with Samantha Whelan Kotkas.
